## Installing the SAP Agent in Windows 2000 Server

Windows 2000 Server can be configured as a SAP agent to maintain a list of the available NetWare servers and services on the network. This how-to article describes about installing the SAP agent on a Windows 2000 Server-based computer.

To install the SAP agent, follow these steps.

- 1. Right-click Network Neighborhood on desktop, and then click Properties.
- 2. In the **Network and Dial-up Connections** dialog box, right-click **Local Area Connection**, and then click **Properties**.
