Showing Build Number Of Windows 2000 on Desktop

This article describes how we can configure Windows 2000 so that the build number is displayed on the desktop.

Note: Use Registry Editor at your own risk. Improper usage of this tool may damage your OS.

Please follow these steps.

- 1. Click Start→ Run.
- 2. In the Open box, type regedit, and then click OK.

- 3. Locate and click the following registry key:
- 4. HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Control Panel\Desktop
- 5. In the right pane, double-click **PaintDesktopVersion**.
- 6. Type 1 in the Value data box, and then click OK.



- 7. Click Exit on the Registry menu.
- 8. Log off, and then log on to the computer.

The build number is displayed in the lower-right corner of your desktop, for example:

Windows 2000 Professional Build 2195

NOTE: To remove this number, repeat the previous steps and type 0 in the **Value data** box.
