

Sending Fax Through Web Browser

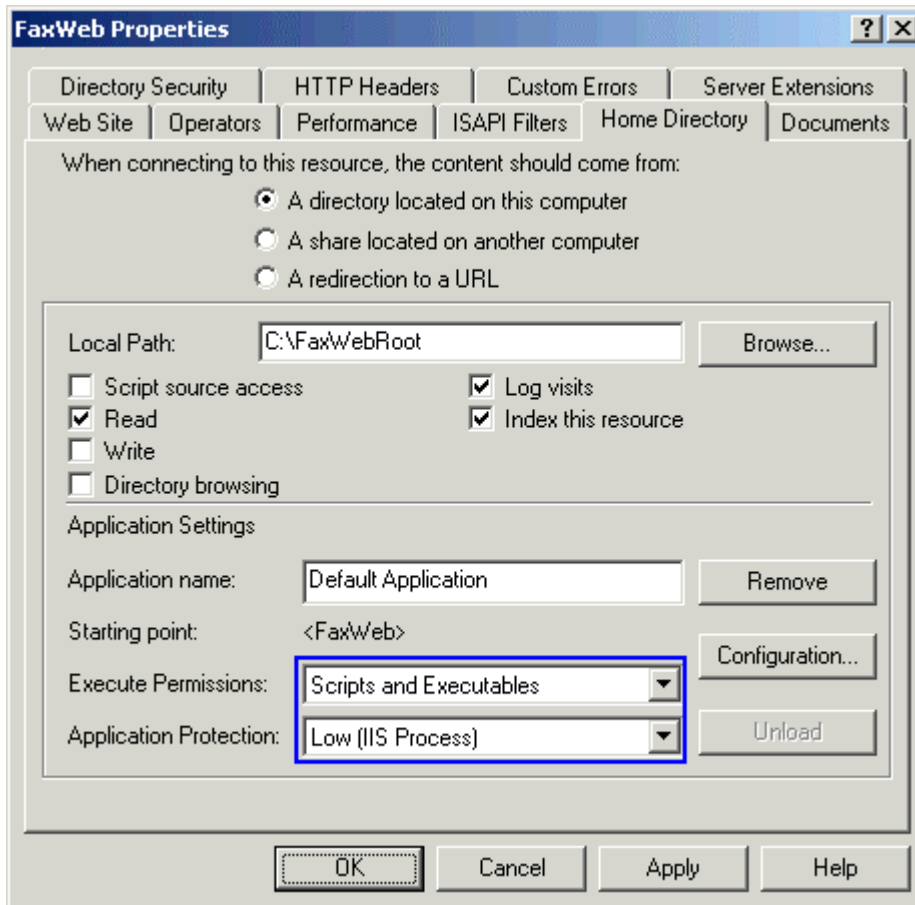
In this article we will provide you step by step instructions about sending Faxes through a web browser.

To perform this exercise, you should have

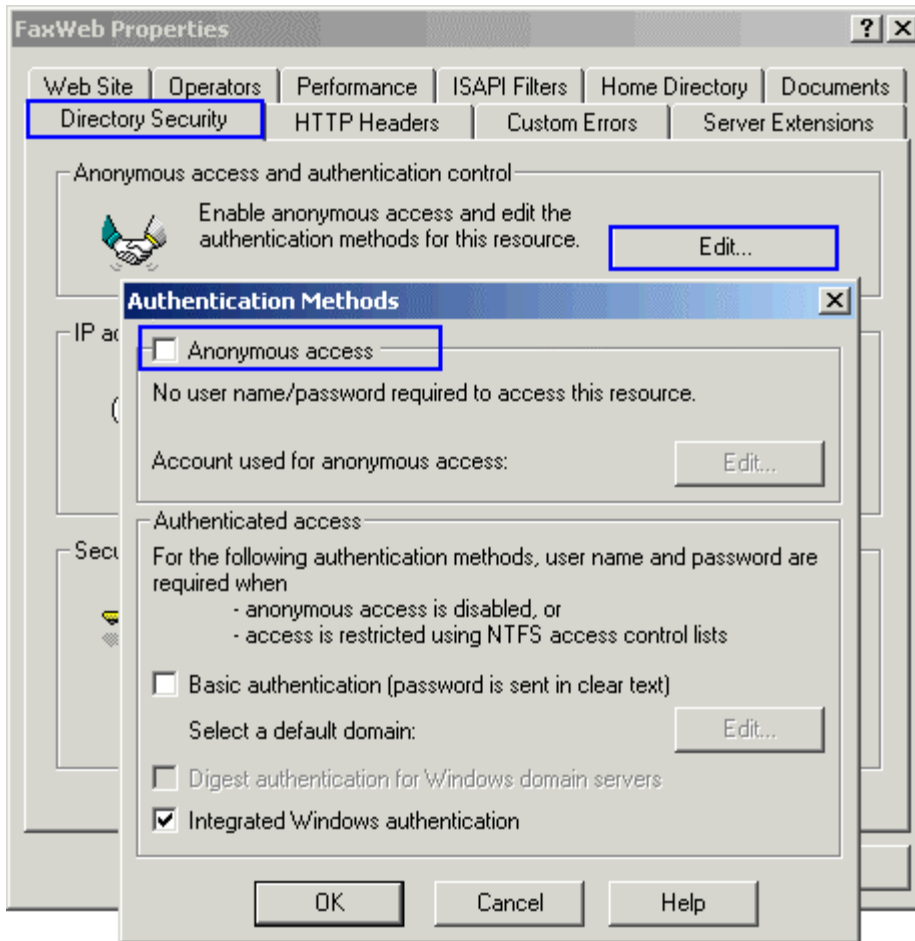
- Installed and running Internet Information Service (IIS).
- Installed and running Fax Service.

Please follow these steps to accomplish this task.

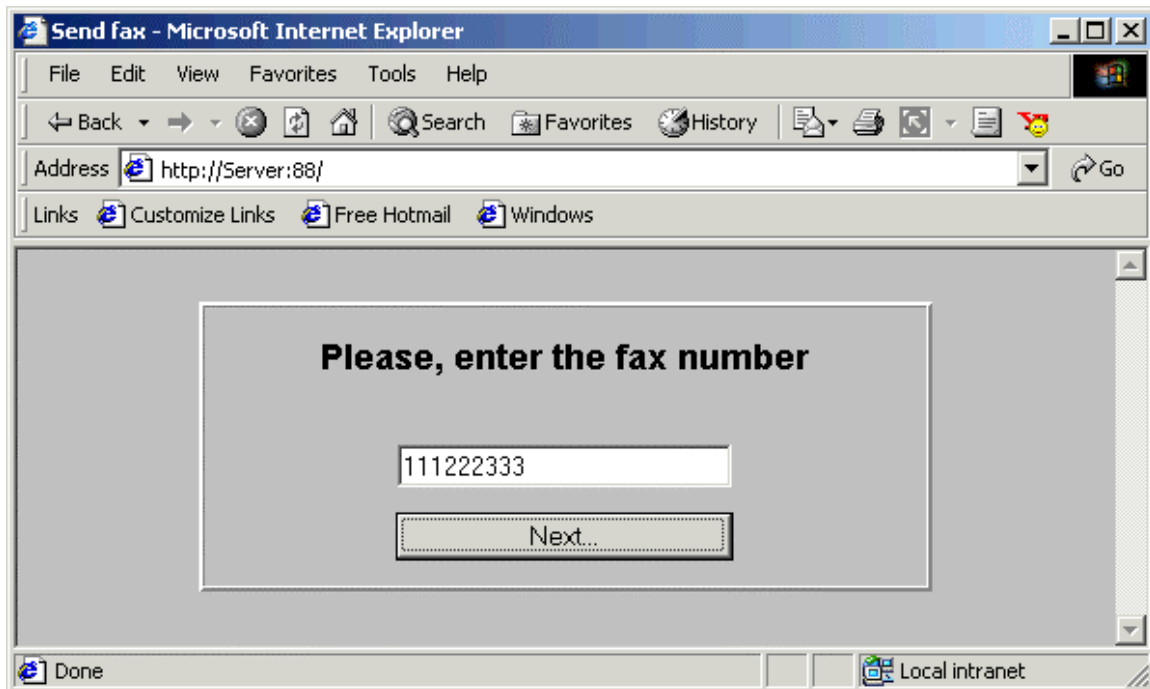
1. Create a new folder on your C drive with the name **FaxWebRoot**.
2. Copy the contents of **Faxweb** folder (attached with this file) to the **FaxWebRoot** folder.
3. Access Internet Service Manager.
4. Create a test website named **FaxWeb** and define the **Home Directory** for this website the FaxWebRoot folder.
5. Modify the **Execute Permissions** to “**Scripts and Executable**” and **Application Protection** to “**Low (IIS Process)**” for this website as shown below.



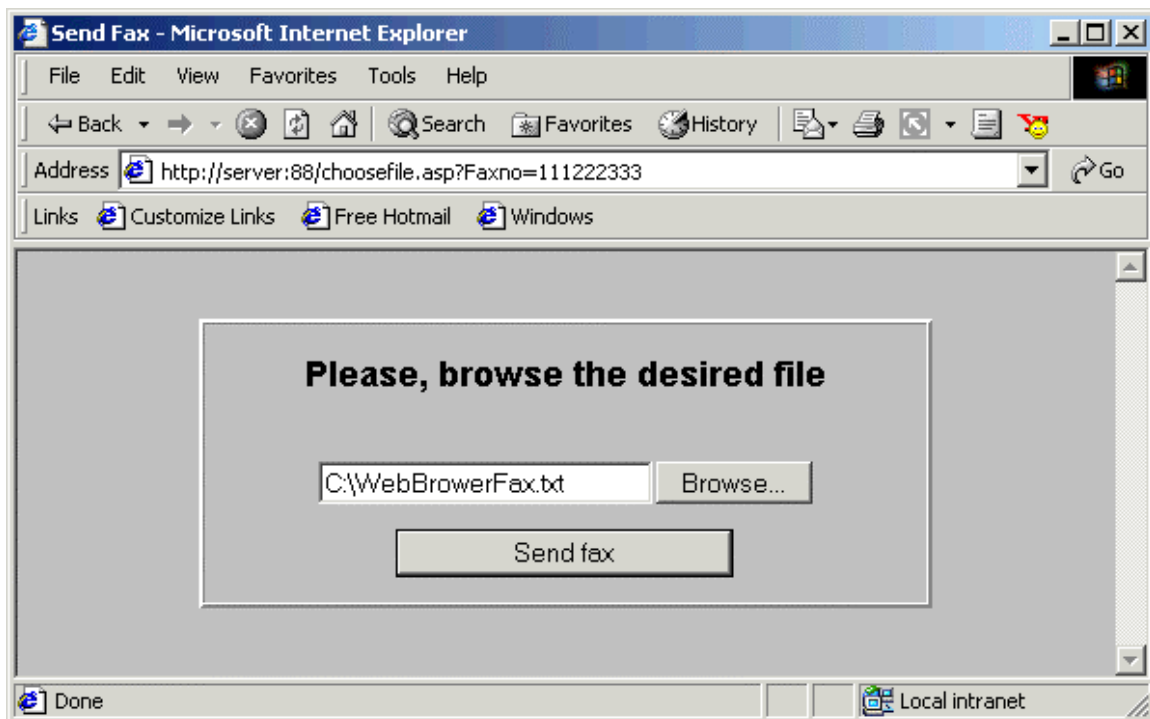
Note: Additionally, you can prevent the **Anonymous Access** for this website for additional security.



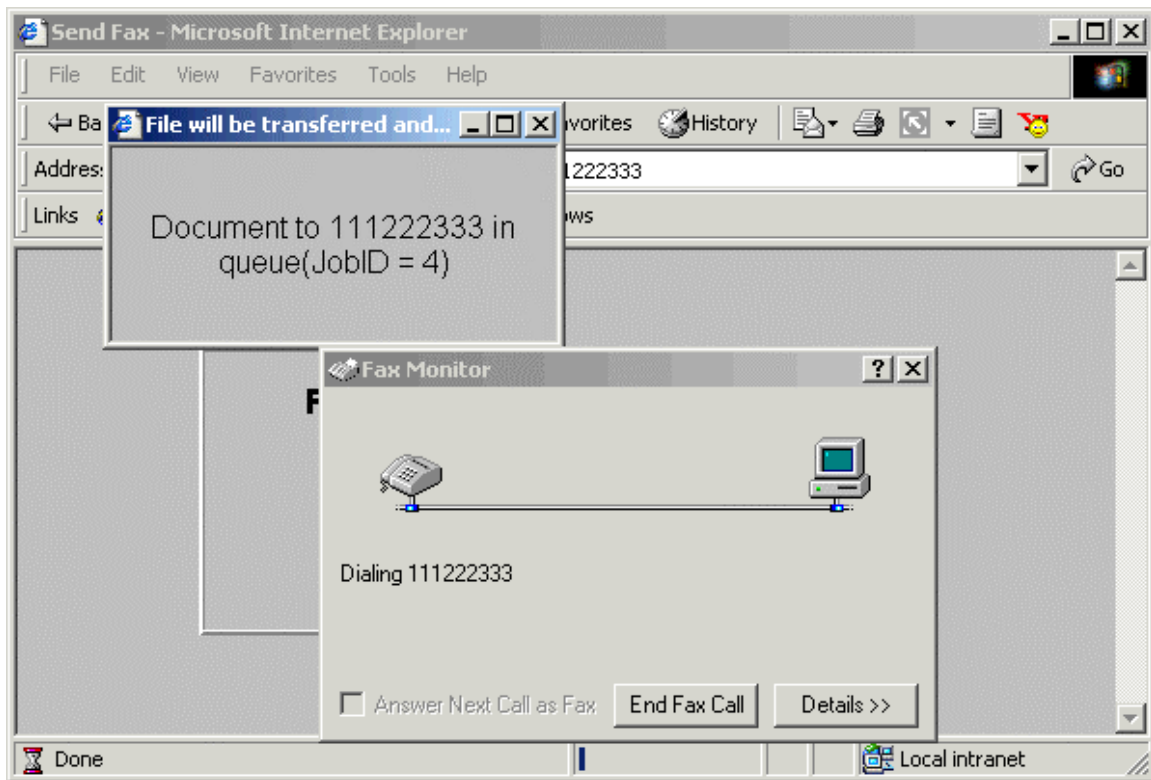
6. Now access your **FaxWeb** at your specified address.
7. Enter the **Fax Number** where you want to send the fax and click **Next**.



8. **Browse** the desired file that will be faxed and click **Send fax**.



9. You will get the **Progress and Status** for your fax job in the next step. If the number you have entered to send fax is correct, your fax will be sent to this number successfully.
